Under Departmental Reports, Water/Sewer Superintendent Robert Campbell reported that the work on Well #5 is complete, that several manholes north of the new detention pond need to be regrouted to prevent water infiltration; the City has received its new NPDES permit and the timeline for the EPA order to correct the Sewer Plant has begun and that the recently approved Aveka agreement was modified to test for Selenium. The Council was informed that five of the lift stations don't have back-up power and he would like to get a quote for a generator/trailer unit. Pat Egan - Street Department briefed the council on a storm sewer that had several collapsed areas in the vicinity of 1st Ave NE and 1st St NE.
