Subject to Council approval and the following conditions for display:

- a. Only one such may be placed in front of a single commercial premises.
- b. The sign must be such that it would qualify as an "on-premises sign"
- c. A sign shall not be placed on public property if an open yard exists.
- d. No sign shall be placed on the traveled portion of the street.
- e. The sign must be immediately adjacent to the commercial building, but shall not be attached to it or the public property.
- f. The sign shall not exceed 30 inches in width or 48 inches in height.
- g. No sign shall be approved if its placement would leave less than four (4) feet of unobstructed space on the public sidewalk adjoining the building.
- h. The sign is displayed on public property only during the open business hours of the adjoining business and only during daylight hours.
- i. The sign does not block or hinder access to any doorway or fire exit.
- j. The applicant, as the owner of the sign to be placed on the public sidewalk or other public property, in exchange for approval of this application, hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Waukon and its officers, employees and agents from any claim, liability or expense whatsoever, including reasonable attorney fees, arising from or relating to the presence of the applicant's sign on public property, including but not limited to any claim, liability or expense for any injury to any person or damage to any property.
