Police Chief, Paul Wagner, briefed that they would share information regarding hiring a new police officer at the next council meeting. They are dealing with issues regarding stray dogs and speeding complaints.

Water & Sewer Superintendent, Jim Cooper, briefed on topics including that the Hidden Creek Lift Station is up and running, the Park and Recreation department helped assist the Water and Sewer Department when they were short staffed, and progress is being made at the Waste Water Treatment Plant.

City Manager, Gary Boden, briefed on a few topics including dead trees, a proposal for grant writing and information regarding the audio and visual equipment installation at City Hall.

Mayor, Pat Stone, reported that a solution to the spills at Aveka will be presented at the next Council meeting.

Council member, John Ellingson, stated he would like further discussion on the vacation of property at 4th Street SW and review of utility vehicle ordinances.
