

COUNCIL ROOM-----February 15, 2021

The Waukon City Council met in regular session via an electronic meeting on February 15, 2021 at 7:00 o'clock P.M. in the council room of City Hall, 101 Allamakee Street and via Zoom technology. Mayor Pat Stone presided. The Governor of Iowa declared a public emergency because of the COVID-19 pandemic. It has been determined that if an in-person meeting is impossible or impractical, per Iowa Code Section 21.8, we are permitted to conduct a meeting by electronic means. Under Public Comments: There were no public comments

Under Department Reports:

Park, Rec & Wellness Director, Jeremy Strub briefed that they are finishing up youth activities for winter and working on organizing to get the pool ready. He also discussed the estimate for HVAC repairs. Street Superintendent, Keith Burrett briefed that they are doing regular maintenance. Water & Sewer Superintendent, Jim Cooper briefed that they had three onsite visits today that went well and they have one left tomorrow. Jim invited Ed Askew with Askew Scientific Consulting to speak. Ed discussed the site visits and compliance as well as stating he will be providing a report to Jim with recommendations to the city; for instance, some ways that city code might need to be changed. Police Chief, Paul Wagner briefed that the Iowa Department of Public Health and the Bureau of Emergency and Trauma Services notified them that law enforcement agencies across the State were awarded a grant through the Leona M. and Harry B. Helmsley Charitable Trust for four AED's for the department. Paul notified the Allamakee Community Foundation Grant that they were awarded those funds since the City recently submitted an application for AED's throughout the departments. They conducted nineteen tobacco compliance checks throughout the county, seventeen of which were in compliant. Lastly, they were notified that the anticipated renovation completion date for the Police Station is February 25th.
