Council Member Arvid Hatlan arrived during department reports.

Under Department Reports: Park, Rec & Wellness Director, Jeremy Strub briefed that the large AC Unit at the Wellness Center was fixed. Park and Rec will be hosting a Circus August 12th and 13th with tickets to be sold at Freedom Bank, Waukon State Bank and Fareway; more information will be coming. Water & Sewer Superintendent Jim Cooper briefed that the demolition is progressing well at the old plant and they plan to have a candidate for hire to be approved at the next council meeting. Street Superintendent Keith Burrett briefed that they are still filling cracks and patches on the streets. Police Chef Paul Wagner briefed that they are working with Alliant Energy on rebates. They were approved for the grant for the crossing lights at 9th Street and 3rd Avenue NW and will have the purchase of equipment on the next agenda for approval. Lastly, he mentioned they were approved the grant for vehicles but it still needs to be approved federally.

City Manager Gary Boden briefed that due to project costs, the city will need to get an architect or engineer to draft specs for the portions of the work the city plans to pay for regarding the Tierney Building project. Therefore, the start date of the project might be later than anticipated as those projects will need to be bid out.
