

COUNCIL ROOM-----July 25, 2019

The Waukon City Council met in special session on July 25, 2019 at 7:30 o'clock A.M. in the council room of City Hall, 101 Allamakee Street, with Mayor Pat Stone presiding. Council members present: Gayle Decker, Arvid Hatlan, John Ellingson, and Ben Rausch. Council members absent: John Lydon. Others present: Police Chief Phil Young; Street Superintendent Keith Burrett; Water & Sewer Superintendent Jim Cooper; City Attorney Jim Garrett; WEDC- Ardie Kuhse; and The Standard- Joe Moses.

The Mayor called the meeting to order and requested item number 4- Police Department be placed before item number 3- Hiring of City Manager.
